Plans are required for all building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to Act No. 299 of the Public Acts of 1980, as amended, and shall bear that architect's or engineer's signature and seal, except; <b>1. One-and two-family dwelling containing not more than 3,500 square feet of building area.</b> <b>2. Alterations and repair work determined by the plumbing official to be of a minor nature.</b> <b>3. Assembly, Business, Mercantile and Storage buildings with a required plumbing fixture count less than 12.</b> <b>4. Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00.</b> If work being performed is described above, answer Section IV. "NOT REQUIRED." PLANS MUST BE SUBMITTED BEFORE A PERMIT CAN BE IS SUED.

## V. APPLICANT

Section 23a of the state construction code act of 1972, 1972 PA 230, MCL 125.1523A, prohibits a person from conspiring to circumvent the licensing requirements of this state relating to persons who are to perform work on a residential building or a residential structure. Violators of section 23a are subject to civil fines.

## VI. HOMEOWNER AFFIDAVIT

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## VII. FEE CLARIFICATIONS

MOBILE HOME UNIT SITE: When setting a HUD mobile home in a park, the permit application must include the application fee # 1, Water Service # 7 and Bldg. Drain # 10 When setting a HUD mobile home or Premanufactured home on private property, a permit application must include the application fee, a sewer or building drain, and a water service or water distribution pipe.

**Item #25, Domestic Water Treatment and Filtering Equipment:** A license is not required for the installation of domestic water treatment and filtering equipment that requires modification to an existing cold water distribution supply and associated water piping in buildings if a permit is secured, required inspections performed and the installation complies with the applicable code. If the enforcing agency determines a violation exists, it shall be corrected by the responsible installer. The permit application shall include the application fee, the number of water treatment devices recorded in Item #25 for \$5.00 each and the appropriate water distribution pipe (system) size fee.

**IX. Instructions for Completing Application**

**General:** Plumbing work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with the City of Adrian. All installation shall be in conformance with the Michigan Plumbing Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.** The telephone number for the Inspector will be provided on the permit form. When ready for an inspection, call the Inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The Inspector will need the **job location and permit number.**

**Expiration of Permit:** A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within 180 days after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of 180 days after the time of commencing the work. **A PERMIT WILL BE CLOSED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN 180 DAYS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CLOSED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED. THE CHARGE TO RE-OPEN A CLOSED PERMIT IS \$75.00**
